### Class Description

Using cylinder beads and peyote stitch, this pendant is made with four elongated triangles for the sides and a slightly domed square at the bottom. Nailheads (flatback beads) are added to the sides and bottom to embellish the pendant.

### Supplies

Note: All supplies will be available for purchase at the class or students may bring their own.

Cylinder beads\* in two easily distinguished colors, 4 gr. each (no matte beads)

Nymo D thread to match the beads

Size 10 beading needles (2)

Bead caps, 2

Nailheads (flat-back beads)

Closed ring

\*Cylinder beads are Miyuki Delicas or Toho Treasures or Aikos
