## **Moorish Tile Beaded Beads Workshops with Diane Fitzgerald**

- Cylinder beads in size 11, about 5 gr of each of 4 colors (light, medium, dark and metallic colors; opaque colors work best)
- Nymo D thread
- Size 10 beading needles
- Microcrystalline wax



The intricate patterns of the cornerless cube beads that will be created in this class suggest the tiles found in the Alhambra, a Moorish palace and fortress in Granada, Spain which contain some of the worlds most well-known tiles.

In class students will learn to make a cornerless cube and to create patterns within the squares and triangles that form it. Several patterns are included with the instructions.

Intermediate/Advanced Class. Students must know circular peyote stitch.

A kit to make the necklace as shown will be available by pre-order only for \$35.00. Orders must be placed by June 1.

The Delica colors used in the sample shown are black (#010), red (# 795), moss green (# 262) and old gold (#505).
